

# Dress Code for 2022-2023 School Year

## *Elementary Uniform Policy K5-5th*

Uniforms may be purchased from Everyday Image.

### **For the Boys**

- White or maroon embroidered polo uniform shirt or maroon vest with polo or white oxford underneath
- NHA embroidered sweatshirts (not hoodies) may be worn with a polo shirt underneath
- Khaki uniform shorts or pants may be purchased from anywhere
- Brown or black belt worn with any bottoms that have belt loops
- Socks must be brown, black, maroon, or white only
- Solid black or brown closed-toe shoes, or solid black, white, or brown tennis shoes including styles such as Sketchers and Vans are allowed for everyday class.
- Fridays = Jeans, NHA t-shirt, & athletic or tennis shoes are allowed for \$1.
- NHA Hoodies may only be worn on Fridays with an appropriate shirt underneath
- All basic uniform guidelines must be met as well

### **For the Girls**

- White or maroon embroidered polo uniform shirt or maroon embroidered vest with polo or white peter pan blouse underneath
- NHA embroidered sweatshirts (not hoodies) may be worn with a polo shirt underneath
- Khaki uniform skirts, skorts, shorts, capris, or pants may be purchased anywhere.
- Plaid uniform skirt
- Plaid uniform jumper with white peter pan blouse
- Skirts and jumpers must be no shorter than fingertip length, and you must wear shorts underneath; skorts and shorts must be fingertip length.
- Brown or black belt worn with any bottoms that have belt loops
- Socks must be brown, black, maroon, or white only.
- Solid black or brown closed-toe shoes, or solid black, white, or brown tennis shoes including styles such as Sketchers and Vans are allowed for everyday class.
- Any hair item must be maroon, khaki, or white only - Everyday Image hair items are acceptable.
- Fridays = Jeans, NHA t-shirt, & athletic or tennis shoes are allowed.
- All basic uniform guidelines must be met as well.

### **Outerwear**

- Maroon or Grey Cardigan (embroidered with the NHA emblem/logo) -- V-neck or Crew
- Maroon Fleece Vest or Jacket – Embroidered with NHA emblem/logo
- Maroon or White **Crew Neck** Sweatshirt with a polo underneath – Embroidered with NHA emblem/logo (not hoodie style)

**\*ALL MAROON ARTICLES MUST BE PURCHASED FROM EVERYDAY IMAGE**

**SPECIAL NOTES PLEASE READ CAREFULLY-THESE GUIDELINES APPLY TO ALL GRADES**

\*All outerwear must be purchased from Everyday Image. There are three options. All outerwear must be embroidered with the NHA logo and may be worn inside or outside the classroom.

- \*Maroon polo shirts may ONLY be purchased from Everyday Image due to the variations in color.
- \*Black and white polo shirts may be purchased from other vendors and taken to Everyday Image for embroidery for \$6.50/logo.
- \*Khaki pants may also be purchased at vendors outside of Everyday Image; however, the traditional Khaki color is the only color that will be accepted.
- \*Maroon cardigan sweaters with logos are a recommended part of the school uniform and may be worn inside or outside the classroom.

## **HAIR GUIDELINES**

Young Men: Hair should fall above the collar and above the eyebrows. Man buns, ponytails, samurai looks are not permitted. Braids and twists should also fall above the collar and above the eyebrows. Braids and twists should be neatly kept, often redone. Only natural hair colors/highlights are permitted. Strictly no fauxhawks, mohawks, or designs (like a Nike swoosh, lightning bolts, etc.). Gradual fades are acceptable. If in question, please consult NHA administration. Young Ladies: Hair should be neatly kept and should not fall into the eyes hampering visual field. Only natural colors for highlights, extensions, and braids are permitted. Skunk stripes, two-tone, and KoolAid-colorings are not acceptable. Hair should not be distracting in any way.

# **North Henry Academy**

## **Dress Code for Middle and High School Students**

1. General Guidelines:
  - a. Students should dress appropriately for the weather conditions. Non-uniform winter coats may be worn during the winter months but shall be removed upon entry into the classroom.
  - b. The use of a NHA approved sweater is allowed in the classroom and on chapel days.
  - c. No student may wear body piercings, visible tattoos, or excessive make-up, as determined by the Academy Principal.
  - d. Any modest, solid-colored (black, white, gray), closed-toe shoe is allowed for everyday class.
  - e. Pants (other than PE shorts) shall always be worn with a brown or black belt at the waist and shall not be tucked into socks.
  - f. If a student wears inappropriate attire to school, parents may be called to bring other clothes.
  - g. On Fridays, jeans and NHA T-shirts are allowed for \$1. NHA hoodies are only allowed over an appropriate T-shirt.
  - h. T-Shirts that are in accordance with theme day, are allowed on theme days, at no cost.
  - i. There may be inappropriate hair and dress styles not addressed here that would be handled on a case-by-case basis.
  - j. Previously issued uniforms are allowed to be worn every day in the classroom.
  - k. If the COVID-19 situation persists similar to our present cases (April 2022), students may wear masks; however, masks shall actually cover both nose and mouth. Masks over the chin or neck only, are not allowed.
  - l. Any jewelry should be modest. The school is not responsible for lost or stolen items.
2. Chapel Policy:

- a. Maroon polo from Everyday Image embroidered with NHA logo, khaki pants, and brown or black leather shoes (non-athletic) shall be worn on chapel days.
  - b. No hoodies or sweatshirts are allowed on chapel days.
3. Hair:
- a. Both male and female students shall have neatly styled hair, as determined by the Academy Principal.
  - b. Hair shall remain or resemble a natural color hair tone. Highlights are acceptable, within reason, if needed, as determined by the Academy Principal.
  - c. No mohawks, or extreme hair styles are allowed.
  - d. Afros are not to be taller than three inches.
  - e. Hair shall not distract the vision.
  - f. For male students, hair shall not be longer than collar length.
4. For Male Students:
- a. Any color business-style pants are allowed so long as they are not denim, leggings, lycra, or workout material.
  - b. Any collared shirt, sweatshirt, jacket or hoodie is allowed so long as it has the NHA logo on it and it may be worn on regular school days. NHA T-shirts are allowed only on special theme days.
  - c. No other T-shirts or tank tops are allowed.
  - d. PE uniform shirt and shorts are for PE and PE only. Athletic socks and shoes shall be worn at PE.
  - e. Male students shall not wear earrings.
5. For Female Students:
- a. Any color or business-style pants, skirts, or dresses are allowed so long as they are not denim, leggings, lycra, or workout material.
  - b. Skirts shall be no shorter than two inches above the knees.
  - c. Any collared shirt, sweatshirt, jacket or hoodie is allowed so long as it has the NHA logo on it may be worn on regular school days. No T-shirts or spaghetti straps are allowed.
  - d. Shoulders shall be covered.
  - e. PE uniform shirt and shorts are for PE and only PE class. Athletic socks and shoes shall be worn at PE.
