

Uniform Guidelines for 2021-2022 School Year

ELEMENTARY SCHOOL (K5 – 5th)

Boys & Girls Category

Bottoms: Khaki pants with belts

Tops: Maroon, White, or Black embroidered polo shirts
& Maroon cardigan sweaters with logo

Shoes: Closed-toe, brown or black solid color shoes, tennis shoes are for recess only

Outerwear: Maroon Fleece, Maroon medium-weight, Maroon heavy coat (embroidered)

Special Notes

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY- THESE GUIDELINES APPLY TO ALL GRADES

*All outerwear must be purchased from Everyday Image this year. There are three options. All outerwear must be embroidered with the NHA logo and may be worn inside or outside the classroom.

*Maroon polo shirts may only be purchased from Everyday Image due to the variations in color.

*Black and white polo shirts may be purchased from other vendors and taken to Everyday Image for embroidery for \$6.50/logo.

*Khaki pants may also be purchased at vendors outside of Everyday Image; however, the traditional khaki color is the only color that will be accepted.

*Maroon cardigan sweaters with logos are a recommended part of the school uniform and may be worn inside or outside the classroom.

Hair Guidelines

Young Men- Hair should fall above the collar and above the eyebrows. Man buns, ponytails, Samurai looks are not permitted. Braids and twists should also fall above the collar and above the eyebrows. Braids and twists should be neatly kept, often redone. Only natural hair colors/highlights are permitted. Strictly no fauxhawks, mohawks, or designs (like a Nike swoosh, lightning bolts, etc.). Gradual fades are acceptable. If in question, please consult NHA administration.

Young Ladies- Hair should be neatly kept and should not fall into the eyes hampering visual field. Only natural colors for highlights, extensions, and braids are permitted. Skunk stripes, two-tone, and Kool-Aid-coloring are not acceptable. Hair should not be distracting in anyway.

MIDDLE & HIGH SCHOOLS (6th – 12th)

Young Ladies & Young Men Category

Bottoms: Khaki pants

Belts: Brown or Black

Tops: Maroon, White, or Black polo shirts (collared, 2 or 3 buttons, embroidered),
Maroon cardigan sweaters with logo

Shoes: Closed-toe, brown or black solid color shoes

Outerwear: Maroon Fleece, Maroon medium-weight, Maroon heavy coat (embroidered)

MS/HS Special Details:

1. Chapel day outfit (for ladies and gentlemen) = khaki pants, embroidered black polo, closed toe brown or black shoes, embroidered maroon outerwear if needed.
2. Khaki pants should be the traditional color of khaki – no brick khaki, khaki green, etc.
3. Khaki pants should be in the uniform pant style with a loose fit including no banding at the ankle's styles. Cargo/painter styles are also not permitted.
4. Belts must be worn if pants do not naturally stay on the waist.
5. Shirts do not have to be tucked in but may be required for certain activities/events.
6. Hoodies are not acceptable forms of outerwear and may only be worn on special occasions that are pre-planned.
7. Jean days will be announced but will not be every Friday this year. The Student Council will be deciding on the dates, which will be forthcoming.
8. When jeans are allowed, spirit wear shirts will be allowed. Spirit wear has our school's name or initials and may be thematic (from a summer day camp or a sports team) and may include our Lion mascot or other NHA identifiers.
9. PE uniform & athletic shoes are only worn during PE class and should be brought in a separate bag to be kept in each student's locker. PE uniforms are not acceptable school wear during a normal academic day. If PE is a student's last class of the day, the student may leave school in their PE uniform and athletic shoes, but the student will have to be responsible to remember to bring their uniform in for the next PE day.
