

Preschool Uniform Policy for K3 and K4

Although we do not require Preschool students to wear a NHA Uniform, we do expect the following:

- Anything, such as shorts or pants with words written on the bottom are NOT permitted
- Clothing that is too small or tight, too big, or too short may not be worn
- Clothes with inappropriate writing or pictures that would be offensive may not be worn
- Waist and midriff must be covered at ALL times
- Tank tops or spaghetti strap shirts or dresses are NOT permitted at any time
- Girls wearing dresses must wear shorts underneath
- Clothing with holes or tears should not be worn at any time
- No oversized or sagging pants or shirts
- No one piece outfits, rompers or overalls should be worn because this may cause accidents during potty time.
- All preschool students must always have a clean change of clothes with undergarments, socks, and extra pair of shoes available in case of accidents. These clothes can be in their bookbag or in a Ziploc bag, labeled with the child's name. Make sure to change out the clothes for the season and for fit.
- All shoes should be CLOSED TOE. No open toed sandals or flip flops.
